Shaun wants to know.

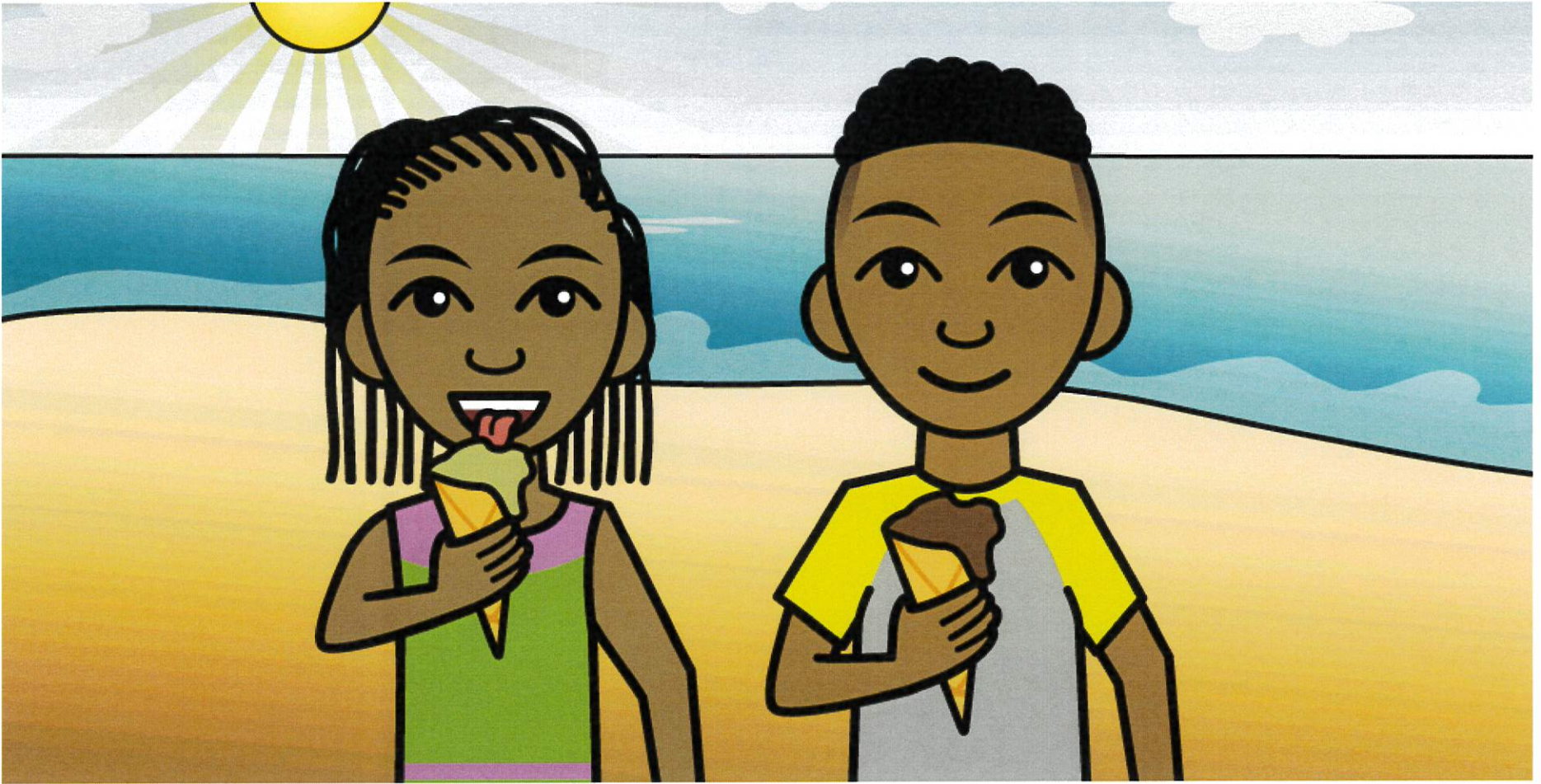


Shaun grabs his water bottle.

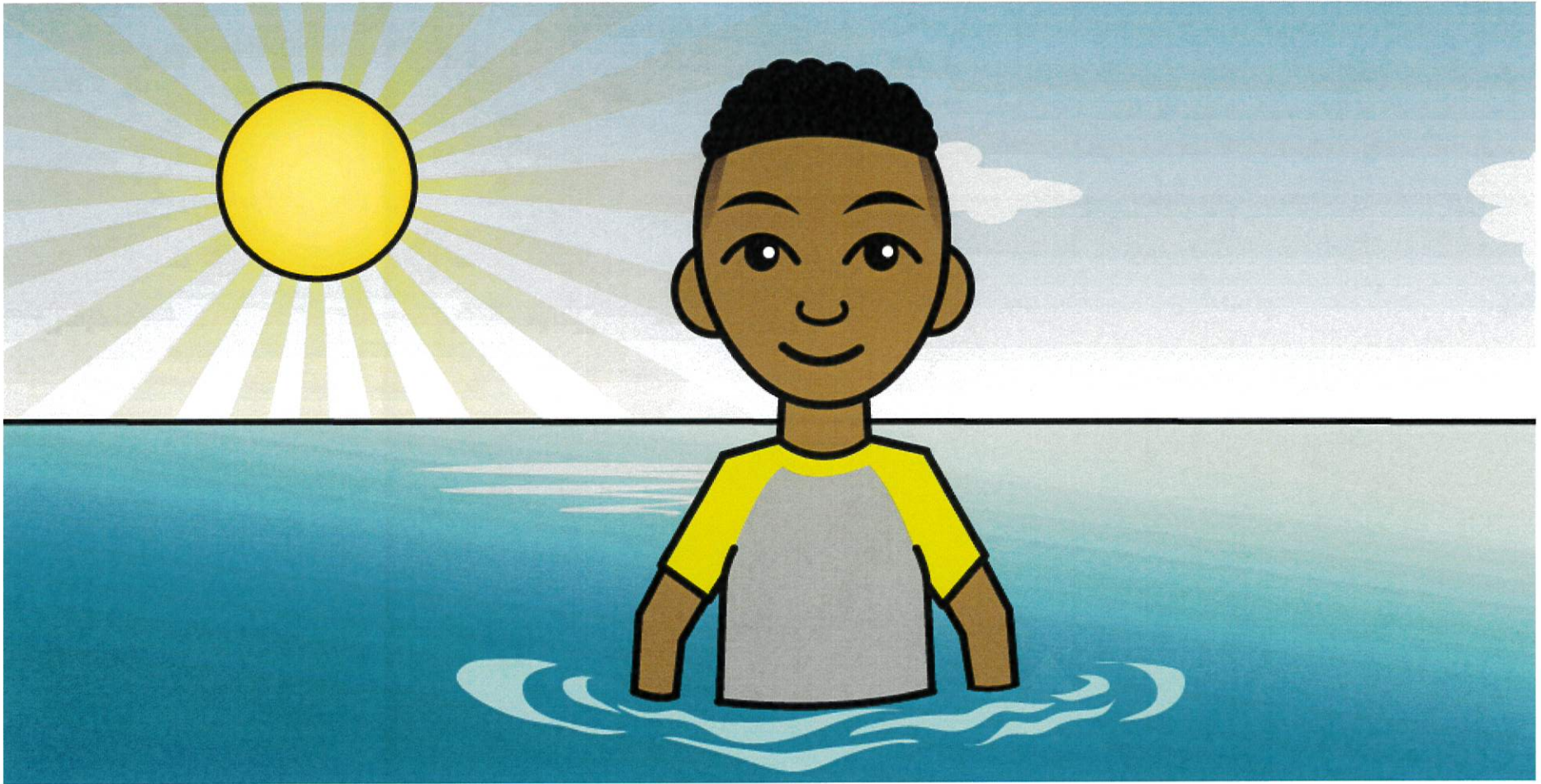
There were ice cubes in the water bottle, but they melted.

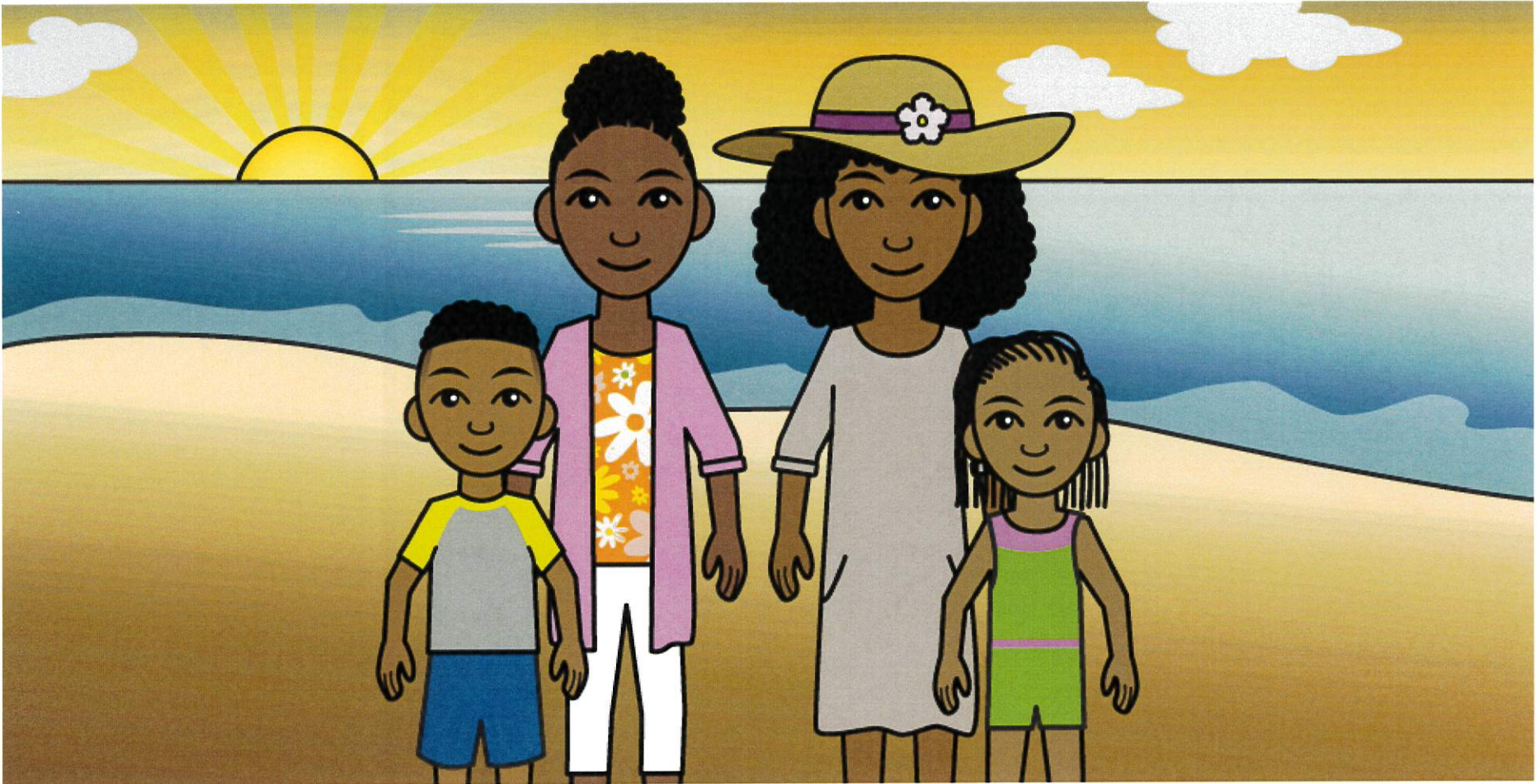
**Shaun buys ice cream for himself and his sister.

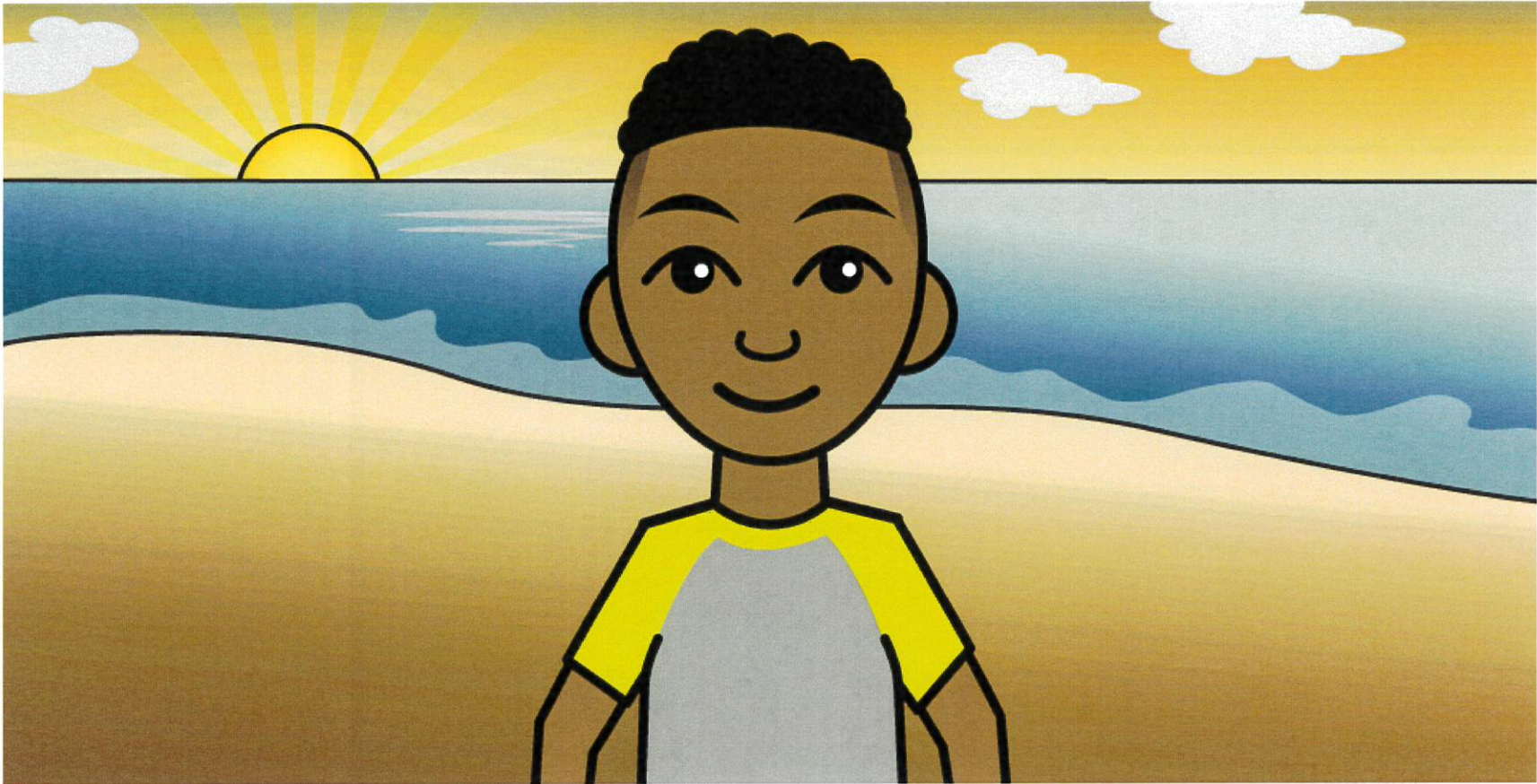
**Shaun jumps in the water to cool off.

Shaun wants to know.**



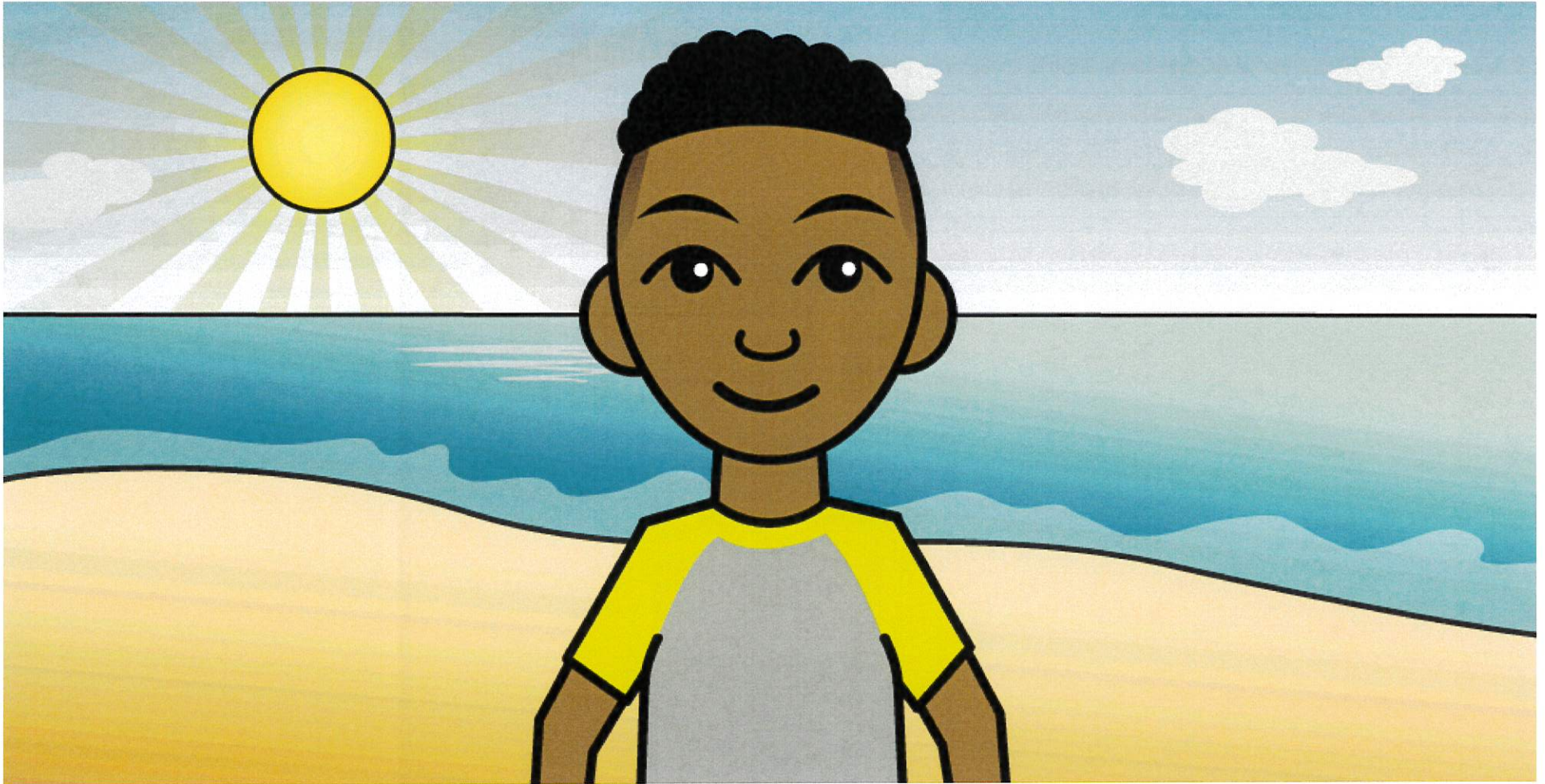
Shaun grabs his towel to dry off.
