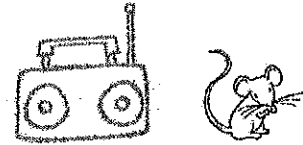

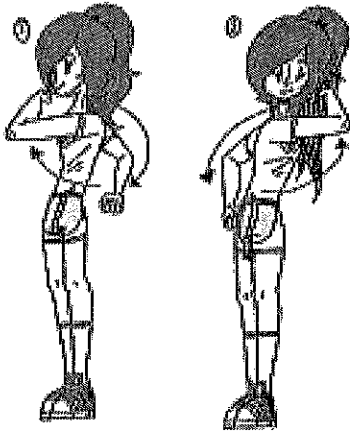


<b>pp - pianissimo (very soft)</b>

<b>&gt; - decrescendo (gradually getting softer)</b>	

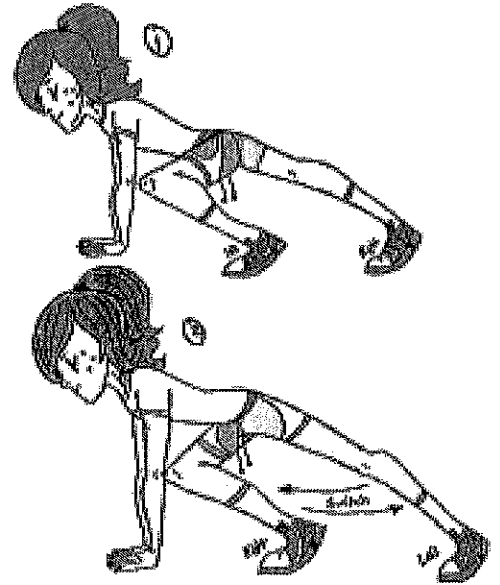


