Physical Maps show features on the Earth's surface. Directions: Create your own physical map. Note: Water is generally colored blue













Near the top of the page, draw a curved line that looks like an upside-down Add a wavy line to connect the ends of the upside down "U." From both bottom sides of this ice cream scoop, add a curved line down. Draw another wavy line to finish the shape. Draw curved lines down from each side of the second scoop



Add a wavy line to finish the bottom scoop of ice cream. Finish with a big "V" shape to make the cone.



Draw lines on the cone to give it texture. Add drips from the ice cream.



Add a kawaii-inspired face to each scoop of ice cream.
