Financial need is not a factor.

Application Deadline

All applications must be postmarked no later than March 19, 2022. Shortly after this date, all applications received will be reviewed. Personal interviews with finalists will be conducted. It is expected that the award winners will be notified prior to the beginning of the Fall semester.

Number of Scholarships to be Awarded

Up to twenty (20) scholarships will be awarded with a maximum individual value of \$1,000 each. Additional scholarships are all available based on residency and academic performance, up to a total value for all scholarships of \$3,200 per applicant. Funds from these scholarships will be applied to your cost of attendance at Iowa State University.
