Later years, Amy joined the team and took over the book-keeping and advertising. Since this duo joined together, they have since opened a location in Corning, Iowa in 2024 and Shenandoah, Iowa in 2025.

This scholarship is awarded to a high school senior living in Adams, Cass, and Page County, Iowa who is pursuing a career as a mechanic. The recipient will be the person who has best demonstrated, in the judgement of the scholarship trustees, the same passion for mechanic and quality of character that the Blaine's exemplify in their lives.

Scholarships will be awarded in the amount of \$1,000. The scholarship may be used for tuition, books and fees or tools.

Qualification

Scholarships will be awarded competitively based on the following criteria:

- Student is a legal resident of Adams, Cass or Page County, Iowa
- Student has a minimum Grade Point Average (GPA) of 2.5 or higher
- If not in an automotive, diesel or collision repair program, student must have 3-4 years of math.
- Community and/or church involvement

- Completed scholarship application

- Resume
- Essay – Questions listed on the application
- A signed letter of recommendation from your automotive, diesel or collision repair instructor (if applicable)

When to apply

Deadline for applications to be received is April 1st of the graduating year.
