Criteria:

- Resident of Adams County, as requested by the family.
- 3.5 or better GPA.
- Plans to attend a four-year college or university.
- Citizenship and leadership in high school and community activities.

Eligibility:

Any full-time Southwest Valley High School senior who meets the above criteria is eligible to apply for this scholarship.

Application Procedure: Include **letter of application and resume.**

- Letter should include primary interests, hobbies, future plans, and goals.
- Resume should include high school and community activities.

Selection Process:

The Corning Education Foundation with the approval of Diane Wilmarth Miller or her family representative will choose the recipient of this scholarship.

Disbursement:

Payment of the award will be made after the student completes the first term of college and submits a copy of grades to the SWV guidance counselor by the deadline date. If the student has maintained a 2.0 GPA in at least 12 credit hours and is enrolled in at least 12 credit hours for the second term, the counselor will authorize the Corning Education Foundation to make the payment.

Deadline: Submit a letter and resume to the SWV High School Counselor by **April 17, 2026**.
