

Adeline Roberts Elder Memorial Art Scholarship

In memory of Adeline Roberts Elder, a scholarship was established for a SWV High School graduating senior, seeking a college degree in art. An emphasis in painting and sculpture is especially encouraged. In the event that no student is majoring in art, the scholarship will not be awarded for that year.

Eligibility:

- Graduate of SWV High School
- Seeking a college degree in art

Additional Criterion:

- Evidence of an interest and talent in art
- High school and community involvement

Application Procedure: The application should be in the form of a letter. Include:

- A paragraph indicating why art has been important to you.
 - Education Plans and why you plan to major in art.
 - Future long-term goals.
- Description of art projects and interest in art-related activities.

Selection Process:

Corning Education Foundation will choose the recipient of this scholarship.

Disbursement:

Payment of the award will be made after the student completes the first term of college and submits a copy of grades to the SWV school counselor by the deadline date. If the student has maintained a 2.0 GPA in at least 12 credit hours and is enrolled in at least 12 credit hours for the second term, the counselor will authorize the Corning Education Foundation to make the payment.

Deadline: The applicant must submit an application **letter and resume** to the SWV High School Counselor by April 10th.
