

Rose Ann Auxiliary Health Career Scholarship

2026 Scholarship Information
(Deadline for Submission is April 3, 2026)

The Rose Ann Auxiliary of CHI Health Mercy Corning has established two \$500 scholarships to be used during the 2026-2027 academic year of post high school education. Listed below are eligibility requirements for this scholarship.

Requirements:

- Be a graduating senior from area high schools: Southwest Valley, Lenox, or Bedford
- Show combination of merit and community service
- Enrolled and accepted into a post high school field of study vocational or bachelor degree program with a health career emphasis. (*Veterinary related fields of study do not qualify*)
- Complete application form including the Essay, minimum of 100 words and the topic is listed on application
- Include copy of high school transcript, include ACT or SAT scores
- Applicants are encouraged to apply with a cover letter outlining why they think they would be good candidates for the scholarship and may wish to highlight the areas considered for scholarship including any work experience.

There are four areas considered in the scholarship application with each area given points, for a total of up to 100 points considered for each applicant.

1. Plans for Future Education *20 points max*
2. Grades, High School Activities & Leadership in Activities *20 points max*
3. Citizenship & Leadership Involvement in the Community *20 Points max*
4. Essay *40 points max.*

Scholarship will be distributed to the award winner after the first semester of continued studies in an accredited program. Recipient must provide copy of grades to the Hospital Volunteer Director by January 15 after the first semester and a check will be issued by the end of January to the scholarship recipient's educational institution.

This application is due in the Volunteer Director's Office by April 3, 2026
