Requirements

- Must be planning to attend a four year college or university with an Ag Major or a two year Vo-Tech program with an Ag focus
- Must have a 3.0 grade point average during their high school career
- Financial need

Submit the following to the Southwest Valley School Counselor

- Letter of application/resume
 - Grade transcript from high school
- Reference letter from a community leader, professional, or school staff
- Personal letter indicating why he/she is deserving of this scholarship

Disbursement of funds

Payment of the funds will be made after the student(s) complete(s) the first term of college and submits a copy of grades and 2nd semester enrollment verification to the SWV High School Counselor. If the student has maintained satisfactory grades and is enrolled for the 2nd term, the
