Behind the Shields Board of Directors is accepting applications for a one-time \$500 Behind the Shields Scholarship for high school students who meet the following criteria:

- The student must live in Montgomery County or be enrolled in Red Oak, Stanton, Southwest Valley, Griswold School District.
- The applicant must be a high school senior who intends to enroll in a two-year or four-year college in the fall following graduation. Also, enrollment into an EMT or Paramedic program within six months after high school graduation would be acceptable.
- The student must be studying either Criminal Justice, Emergency Medical Services or Fire Science.
- The student must have cumulative grade point average of 3.0 or higher at the conclusion of the first semester of his/her senior year.
