

Scholarship Information

The Adams Community Chamber of Commerce has established a \$250 scholarship for the 2021-22 academic year. Listed Below are the eligibility requirements for this scholarship.

Requirements

- ► Be a graduating high school senior/resident of Adams County or a graduating senior from Southwest Valley High School
- ► Show combination of merit and community service
- ► Enrolled and accepted into a post high school field of study vocational or bachelor's degree program
- ► Complete application form including the Essay, minimum of 100 words and select from the topic list on application
- ► Applicants are encouraged to apply with a letter outlining why they think they would be a good candidate for the scholarship and may wish to highlight the areas considered for scholarship.

There are four areas considered in the scholarship application with each area given a maximum of 25 points, for a total of up to 100 points considered for each applicant.

- 1. Plans for Future Education
- 2. High School Activities & Leadership in Activities
- 3. Citizenship & Leadership Involvement in the Adams Community/Chamber Activities work experience may be included here
- 4. Essay

Scholarship funds will be distributed to the award winner after the first semester of continued studies in an accredited program once at least 12 credit hours with a 2.0 GPA or higher are completed. Recipient must provide a copy of grades to the Chamber Office (710 Davis Avenue) by January 31, 2023. A check will be issued to the scholarship winner to be used as needed to support educational goals.

This application is due in the SWV High School guidance office by April 1, 2022.
