

American Legion Scholarship

Corning American Legion Post 117 will give two scholarships.

Eligibility:

- Any SWV graduating senior
- Plans to attend a post-secondary school: (2-4 year college, vocational/technical institute)
- Preference given to applicants with a parent or grandparent that is a veteran

Application Procedure: The application should be in the form of a letter and must include

- Information about the applicant and his/her family
- Statement of need for the scholarship
- High school transcript

Selection Process:

Legion membership will review applications and choose the recipient of the scholarship.

Disbursement:

Payment of the award will be made after the student completes the first term of college and submits a copy of grades to the SWV guidance counselor by the deadline date. If the student has maintained a 2.0 GPA in at least 12 credit hours and is enrolled in at least 12 credit hours for the second term, the counselor will authorize the Corning Education Foundation to make the payment. Scholarship must be used in the year after it is awarded.

Deadline:

The applicant must submit an application letter to the SWV High School Guidance Counselor by April 25th, 2024.
